3RD ANNUAL REPORT (2016-17)

The Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya (MSSV) is the outcome of an ambitious scheme of the Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha, the biggest religio-cultural, socio-economic, non-political and non-government organisation of the North-East India. To sponsor the University the Sangha had formed a Trust in the name and style of the Srimanta Sankaradeva Education and Socio-Economic Development Trust (SSESEDT) registered under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 vide Regd. No. 244/S/2091/IV, dated 23/08/2013. The Trust had submitted a Detailed Project Report (DPR) under the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007 to the Govt. of Assam for the establishment of the University. On the basis of the DPR the Govt. of Assam accomplished all the formalities for the establishment of the University. As a result Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya (MSSV) was established vide ASSAM ACT No. XIX of 2013 notified in THE ASSAM GAZETTE NOTIFICATION No. LGL.59/2013/16 on 14th August, 2013 under The Assam Private Universities Act, 2007 (ASSAM ACT No. XII of 2007).

LOCATION OF THE UNIVERSITY:

The Govt. of Assam had allotted to the University a plot of land measuring 60 Bighas 2 Kathas 10 Lochas in the Village Atuwatika Pathar, Hatichung under Sadar Revenue Circle, Nagaon District. The plot of land is located about 8 km from the Nagaon Town on the side of the Nagaon-Bordowa-Dhing Road. The Sponsoring Body of the University has taken action for the development of the plot of land by installing RCC boundary posts on all the sides, earth filling of a portion of the land and other construction works.

At present the University has started functioning in the Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha Complex situated in the Haladhar Bhuyan Path, Kalongpar in the heart of the Nagaon Town.

FUNCTIONING OF THE UNIVERSITY:

The Hon'ble Governor of Assam and Visitor of MSSV approved the appointment of Shri Rajani Kanta Dutta, Padadhikar, Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha as the First Chancellor of the University as per the provision of the Clause No. 16(I) of the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007 vide No. DSA.56/2013/14 dated 28th January, 2014.



However, the University started functioning w.e.f 10th June, 2014 when Prof. Kandarpa Kumar Deka, former Vice-Chancellor of the Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh joined the University as its First Vice-Chancellor. The normal activity of the University actually was started w.e.f. 10th June, 2014. The First Registrar of the University Prof. Ratul Chandra Borah, Retired Professor and Dean i/c, of Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat had joined on 17th June, 2014.


OTHER ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:
