- Rati- A unit of measuring gold
- Sanyāsa—An ascetic life
- *Tola* Residential Schools
- Tolā two-fifths of an ounce or 96 ratis
- Vrndāvanī-Vastra—The cloth on which the weavers weave the childhood activities

of Kṛṣṇa in Vrindavan as designed by Śańkaradeva

Pāiks—The peasants in Āhom Kingdom who were required to provide

compulsory military service and manual labours as land revenue
