# MAHAPURUSHA SRIMANTA SANKARADEVA VISWAVIDYALAYA

## ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

### Introduction:

Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva (1449-1568) was a multi-dimensional genius, who transformed and modernized Assamese society with his egalitarian ideology. He worked in diverse fields like religion, literature, music, dance, drama, architecture, social reconstruction, etc. He translated most part of the Bhâgavata Mahapurana into Assamese language and was the first ever playwright in any Indian language other than Sanskrit. He wrote more than 26 (twenty six) scriptures mostly in Assamese language besides the Brajawali form and one in Sanskrit. In addition he had composed many lyrics/songs including the Borgeets. All these justify to call him SARVAGUNAKARA by his most loyal disciple Madhabadeva. His philosophy too was unique and different from other branches of Hindu philosophies. Above all he was a humanist. He welcomed every one irrespective of caste, creed, sex into his order. He was also a pioneer in adult education, mass communication, etc. He called upon the society to educate women and the downtrodden people.

Srimanta Sankaradeva founded a whole new school of art. He initiated a new form of painting with his epoch-making drama-festival Chihna-Yâtrâ held in 1468 A.D. where he drew the imaginary pictures of heaven to be used as backdrops. He encouraged illustration of his manuscripts with pictorial depiction of stories from the Bhâgavata. The Nâmghar founded by him has become a multi-dimensional institution and symbol of Assamese society. He visited many places



of the Indian sub-continent and his impact was clearly felt in those regions, be it Yâtrâ of Bengal, scroll painting of Odisha, plays of Mithila, etc.

Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha was set up in 1930 in order to carry forward the reforms initiated by the saint. It is the largest NGO in North East India and it has been working relentlessly among the masses for inculcating the values preached by Srimanta Sankaradeva. It is running several schools in the state to spread value based education. The Sangha envisaged to establish a University and authorised its Srimanta Sankaradeva Education and Socio-Economic Development Trust, Nagaon to sponsor the establishment of the University. The Sangha submitted a proposal to the Government of Assam for establishment of the University under the Assam Private Universities Act, 2007. The Assam Legislative Assembly passed 'The Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya Act, 2013'. The Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly (Assam Act No. XIX of 2013) received the assent of the Hon'ble Governor of Assam vide : No. LGL.59/2013/16 and notified it in the Assam Gazette No. 351 dated 14th August, 2013.

The newly set up Mahâpurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyâlâya has formally been founded on 10th June, 2014. Though the University has been set up under the Private University Act, but it is designed as a people's university, an institution for the entire people







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of Assam as well as India. It is located at Nagaon, the place blessed with the dust of the saint's feet for more than half a century, since he lived half of his life at Bardowa, Nagaon. The Mahâpurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyâlaya fraternity firmly believes that a new era of social regeneration will start from this University.

## Academic Aspects:

The Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya has introduced diverse programmes in the disciplines of Arts, Humanities and Law. The University shall put its best efforts to introduce at the earliest, programmes of various levels starting from Certificate to Ph.D. However, considering its nascent stage and limited resources, in case of research programmes, only the **Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.)** and **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Sankaradeva Studies** were introduced in its first academic session, i.e., 2015. The Programme of **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Assamese** was introduced in its 2nd academic session, i.e., 2016. Now, in the academic session 2017 the University has proposed to extend its research programmes by introduction of the **Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in Education, English and Sociology** and **Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in English and Juridical Studies**.

## Semester System:

All the programmes in the University have been run in the Semester System including the Master of Philosophy (M. Phil.) and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.).

## Infrastructure available at present:

The offices and classes of the University, have been arranged in two three storied RCC buildings situated in the Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha Complex, Kalongpar, Nagaon with the following infrastructures:



## Classrooms:

Hygienic classrooms with comfortable seating have been arranged. All classrooms are fitted with eco-friendly boards with provision for LCD projectors.

## Computer Laboratory:

A well designed Computer Laboratory having capacity for 25 students and research scholars at a time has been established.







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## Library:

The University has a rich library with thousands of books of various branches of knowledge. Research scholars shall be issued Library Cards for borrowing books from the library. Provision has also been made for a comfortable Reading Room for the students and research scholars.



## Internet Centre:

An Internet Centre with a capacity for 20 persons at a time shall be arranged at the earliest, so that the students and research scholars can access information through ICT. At present internet access has been provided in the Computer Laboratory. Wi-Fi facilities have also been provided in the building.

## Auditorium:

An auditorium of medium size is available with a large stage where the students and research scholars organise cultural events and functions.

## Sports & Games:

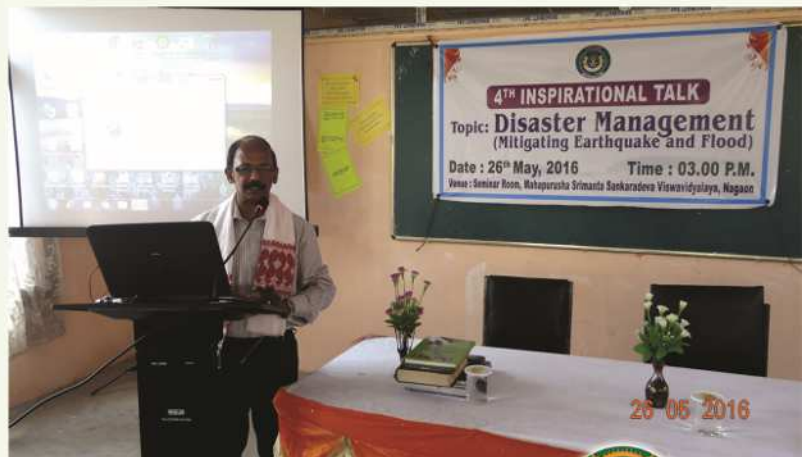
The University in its present campus has no space for arranging sports and games facilities. Therefore, a tie-up with the District Sport authorities of Nagaon District has been made to provide the stadium, indoor stadium and other facilities to the students of the University as and when necessary.

## Students' Aid Fund:

A fund has been created out of the fees collected from the students and research scholars under the head 'Students' Aid Fund'. Really needy students and research scholars are identified and financial aid offered to them at a time of distress.

## Measures for Students' Empowerment:

Various activities, e.g. lectures, discussion, debates, seminars and symposium are arranged frequently in the University Campus to inspire and motivate the students and increase their employability and self-employment.







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## Students' Counselling & Guidance Cell:

To offer proper counselling to the students and research scholars to face the various challenges confronted by them and also to guide them to achieve the desired goals, a Counselling & Guidance Cell comprising of the teachers and officers has been formed.

## Training & Placement Cell:

A Training & Placement Cell has been formed in the University to provide training to the students and research scholars at regular intervals to help them to be successful in getting jobs or starting entrepreneurial activities by themselves. The Cell shall also assist the students and research scholars in getting information regularly regarding availability of job in the various enterprises.

## Grievance Redressal Cell:

To know grievance of the stakeholders, if any, and to take up prompt redressal measures a Grievance Redressal Cell has been constituted in the University.

## Prohibition of Ragging:

Top vigilance has been maintained to ensure that ragging of any form does not take place in the University. Rules, as laid down by the University Grants Commission or other relevant bodies have been strictly followed by the University administration. Measures to create awareness among the students against ragging have been taken earnestly. The research scholars admitted to the University **are to submit Affidavits of their own and parents or guardians.**

## Eligibility for Applying for Admission:

### (A) M.Phil. :

A candidate for admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) must have passed the Post-graduate Examination of this University or any other University/Institute recognised as equivalent by this University securing a **minimum of 55% marks in the subject** in which he/she intends to pursue the course. **5% of marks in the eligibility norms shall be relaxed for the candidates of the reserved category.** Under special circumstances a candidate may be allowed by the Research Council on recommendation of the Departmental Research Committee to pursue the course in a subject other than one in which he/she obtained Masters' Degree, provided that the Research Council is satisfied that the branches are interrelated and the candidate is competent to undertake the programme in the particular subject.

### (B) Ph.D.:

- (i) Persons with post-graduate degree from any recognized University Institute with at least 55% marks or equivalent Grade Point Average (GPA). **5% of marks in the eligibility norms shall be relaxed for the candidates of the reserved category.**
- (ii) Persons working in national institutes / government / private organization nominated / sponsored by the respective employer. These persons should have recognized post-graduate degree, with minimum marks required.
- (iii) Above-noted rules will also be applicable to overseas candidates who have obtained masters degree from the statutory Indian / foreign Universities.
- (iv) Application for research in interdisciplinary subject areas and from applicants belonging to the faculty or subject other than the faculty or subject in which the research project is proposed to be undertaken shall be considered on the basis of the proven competence of the candidate. Application for such research projects will be meticulously examined by the research supervisor and the research committee, subject to confirmation by the Vice-Chancellor, MSSV.
- (v) Admission for foreign students with 55% marks in the Master Degree or equivalent GPA, and relevant Passport and Visa, may be considered, subject to the ratification of the Vice-Chancellor, MSSV.
- (vi) During the pendency of the Ph.D. programme the candidate shall not pursue any other parallel programme or course.



Applications for admission to the M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes shall be scrutinised and a list of eligible candidates to appear in the **Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Research Admission Test (MSSVRAT)** shall be prepared. The list shall be declared on **5<sup>th</sup> January, 2017**. The list of the eligible candidates for MSSVRAT shall be put on the notice board and the University website : [www.mssv.co.in](http://www.mssv.co.in).





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## Processing of applications of Foreign Students:

Applications of foreign students with proper official documents, including passport and visa, either sponsored or non-sponsored, being qualified for admission to the research programme, shall be examined by the Registrar, and the same will have to be ratified by the Vice-Chancellor, subject to the approval of the Academic Council, MSSV.

## Duration of the Programmes:

- (A) **M.Phil.** : Minimum 1 year (Two Semesters) and Maximum of four consecutive semester / two years
- (B) **Ph.D.** : Minimum 3 years including course work and maximum of six years.

## Admission Procedure:

### How to obtain Admission Forms / Information Brochures:

Candidates for admission to the programmes are to apply in the prescribed forms (attached with the Information Brochure) for appearing the Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya Research Admission Test (MSSVRAT). The Information Brochure and Form for MSSVRAT can be obtained in one of the following three ways:

- (i) **From the office of the MSSV, Nagaon** on payment of **Rs. 1,500/-** (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) in **Cash** or **Bank Draft** drawn in favour of the **Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya**, payable at **State Bank of India, Nagaon Main Branch (Code No- 00146)**
- (ii) **By post** by sending a **Bank Draft of Rs. 1,500/-** (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) as described under (i) above along with a **self addressed stamped envelope of 25 cm x 30 cm** size addressed to the **Assistant Registrar (Academic), Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya, Srimanta Sankaradeva Sangha Complex, Haladhar Bhuyan Path, Kalongpar, Nagaon-782001**. The University administration shall, however, not be responsible for non-delivery / late delivery of forms sent through post.
- (iii) Forms can also be **downloaded from the University website : [www.mssv.co.in](http://www.mssv.co.in)**. The filled up downloaded forms must be submitted **along with a Bank Draft of Rs.1,500/-** (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) as described under (i) above.







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## Submission of filled up Admission Forms:

The prescribed application forms shall have to be completed in all respects. Incomplete forms shall be rejected. The completed forms along with attested copies of all required testimonials are to be submitted to the Office of the Registrar, MSSV, Nagaon **within the scheduled last date. Application received after the last date shall not be accepted.**

## Selection Procedure:

Selection of candidates for admission shall be made on the basis of the result of the Mahapurusha Srimanta Sankaradeva Viswavidyalaya Research Admission Test (MSSVRAT) to be held on 10th January, 2017 and result of which shall be declared on 20th January, 2017.

The list of successful candidates shall be put on the Notice Board of the University and also in the website of the University: [www.mssv.co.in](http://www.mssv.co.in). **Intimation to the candidates shall not be conveyed individually. The successful candidates**

**shall be called through e-mail for interview to be held on 23rd & 24th January, 2017 in the University.**

Selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on 30th or 31st January, 2017 on payment of the prescribed fee, failing which selection for admission shall automatically get cancelled.



## Cancellation of Admission:

- (i) A candidate shall forfeit his/her seat, if admission is not taken on the specified date.
- (ii) A research scholar shall also forfeit the seat, if he/she fails to attend classes without valid ground and permission of the Head of the Department concerned for **consecutive 15 (fifteen) days** from the date of commencement of the classes.
- (iii) The name of the research scholar shall also be struck off the Rolls of the University, if he/she is found admitted to other University / Institution during the academic session in which he/she is admitted in the University.
- (iv) Admission of the research scholars may also be cancelled in case they fail to register their names in the University within the notified dates.







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## Admission to next Higher Semester:

Research scholars of the Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.) on successful completion of a semester shall be admitted to the next higher Semester on payment of the Semester fee within the specified period. They must produce the official receipt of the payment of the semester dues to the respective Head of Department for record and to get their names registered in the Department.

## Attendance:

All research scholars shall attend a **minimum of 85% of the total number of classes held** during the course work. In case the percentage of attendance does not fall below 75%, a scholar may be permitted to appear as a 'Non-Collegiate' scholar on payment of prescribed fee. If the percentage of attendance of a scholar during the course work falls below 75% he/she shall be declared as 'Dis-collegiate' and shall not be allowed to appear in the End Semester Examination.



## Reservation of Seats for Admission:

### (i) Statutory Reservation :

- Scheduled Caste (S.C.) : 07% of the intake capacity
- Scheduled Tribes, Plains (S.T.P.) : 10% of the intake capacity
- Scheduled Tribes, Hills (S.T.H.) : 05% of the intake capacity
- OBC / MOBC : 15% of the intake capacity

**NOTE:** For consideration of admission under reserved categories Caste Certificates countersigned by the Deputy Commissioner of the district concerned must be produced.

### (ii) Differently Abled Candidates:

3% of the total seats in each programme shall be reserved for the differently abled candidates.

Candidates applying for admission under this category of reservation must submit Medical Certificate issued by an officer not below the rank of the Joint Director of Health Services of the district concerned.

Candidates with negligible deficiency shall not be considered for admission under this category of reservation.
